“Imagine there’s no Brexit”: EU boss channels Lennon

London.—Since this month’s election, many British voices have joined a debate on how or even if Brexit may happen; yesterday, one EU chief added that of John Lennon, sparking a round of more and less musical replies. Donald Tusk, the former Polish prime minister chairing a summit of EU leaders in Brussels attended by British prime minister Theresa May, spoke of the revival of discussion in Britain since May lost her

government majority on 8 June. “Some of my British friends have even asked me whether Brexit could be reversed, and whether I could imagine an outcome where the UK stays part of the EU. I told them that in fact the European Union was built on dreams that seemed impossible to achieve,” he said, before turning to the late Beatle to clarify. “So, who knows?” said Tusk, citing Lennon’s *Imagine*.
